Learning support is a very flexible and dynamic system in St. Kilian's. It is guided by the requirements of the students each year and usually consists of a mix of the below styles.



It can range from in class support, where different groups in the class are given small group support, following wat is being done in the classroom.



It can involve small groups of students that leave the classroom for a continuous number of weeks or months to work on specific targets.



It can involve students on an individual basis, sometimes supported in the classroom and sometimes given individual support to work on their specific targets.
