School Fees Terms and Conditions



Enrolment

A child can be registered on the school's waiting list by completion of a waiting list form and payment of a registration/waiting list fee of €100 which is non-refundable. Offers for places are normally made in the November preceding the year the child is due to start school. If you wish to accept the offer of a new place for your child in St. Kilian's, a deposit of €1500 is payable per child. The deposit will be credited against the first year's fee payments. The deposit is non-refundable if your child does not take up his/her place for the school year offered. Parents/Guardians are jointly and severally liable for the school fees.

Fees levels for the forthcoming school year are announced in March each year.

Invoicing and payment

Invoices are usually issued in June .

Payment methods: Fee payment options are as follows:

1. Immediate Payment

Payment by bank transfer (details on invoice):

- for the full school year, no later than 14th July

- per term, one third by: July 14th; October 14th and February 14th

2. Monthly instalment by direct debit - July to June

If you wish to join the scheme please e-mail admin@kilians.com for a form which should be completed and sent back to the school. Where a direct debit payment is returned unpaid by the bank, the parents will be asked to pay the relevant amount directly to the school.

3. Late payments

To ensure the school can continue on a firm financial footing, the school will engage with late-paying parents for up to two months. Thereafter, the school may refer the matter to its solicitors. In addition, the school reserves the right:

- (i) to impose 5% interest on overdue fees;
- (ii) not to release any reports or other information in relation to the academic achievements of the child until full payment of all outstanding fees including interest, where applicable;
- (iii) to cancel a child's place during the course of the school year in the event of non-payment of school fees.



Transition Year

Where a student is registered in the school for Transition Year and attends the school for any part of that year, the full year's fees are payable. Except for school organised events, any absence during Transition Year must be approved by the Principal.

In the event that parents wish to send their son/daughter abroad for Transition Year but wish to return for Class 11, full Transition Year fees are payable in order to secure their place in the school for the following school year.

Cancellation of places

Cancellation of school places for the following school year must be received in writing by the Principal prior to 31st March, otherwise full fees are payable for the following school year.
